CRITERIA	SCORE (in figure)
1. Writing format (maximum score 5) The dissertation proposal consists of a title, an approval sheet, a summary, a table of content, an introduction, literature review, conceptual framework and hypothesis, research methods, and a reference.	
2. Planned research title and summary (maximum score 10) The title consists of not more than 20 words, has no abbreviations, and clearly describes research purposes. The summary (in Indonesian and English) includes the background of the problem, research objectives, research methods, plans for data analysis.	
3. Introduction (maximum score 10) It contains the background of the problem, the topics that have been studied and not as the foundation to formulate research problems, the research novelty, the research problems and sub-problems, the general and specific objectives, and the research benefits.	
4. Literature review (maximum score 10) It must be relevant to the title and the problems, state what is known and not known related to the topic, have correct sub-chapters, present a common thread between sub-chapters, present correct presentation of tables, graphs, and pictures explain basic cellular and molecular level mechanisms. Language is good and uses correct Indonesian (not a translation). It presents paragraphs correctly with a common thread between paragraphs.	
5. Thinking framework, conceptual framework, and hypothesis (maximum score 10) The student can create and explain the conceptual framework of his/her research through diagrams or plots briefly based on the literature review used. The conceptual framework can be used as the basis for building research hypotheses.	
6. Mastery of research method (maximum score 10) The student can explain the research methods and references used. Research design and methods can achieve research objectives. If there is a modification of the research method, it must be based on a clear theory. If there is a failure, the student can provide alternative methods. The research topic is feasible and worth studying.	
7. Presentation and answering questions (maximum score 15) The presentation is on time. The student has a clear voice. The student can explain figures, tables, and graphs well. Slides follow the existing rules. The student can answer the question clearly and comprehensively. The student shows good presentation etiquette.	
8. Specific/special knowledge in accordance with the candidate's research field (maximum value 30) The student masters the theory or has good knowledge for conducting research and demonstrate great ability and willingness to solve research problems
