CRITERIA	SCORE
<b>1. Format (maximum score 5)</b> The format consists of: a planned research title (in Indonesian and English), approval from the academic advisor and promoters 1, 2, and 3, an abstract and keywords, review of literature, theoretical framework, and conceptual framework.	
<b>2. Title, abstract, and keywords (maximum score 5)</b> The title should not exceed 20 words in Indonesian and 10-20 words in English, a narrative, communicative, easy to be understood, suitable with the student's field of study, and reflects the depth of the planned research. There is a connection between the title, the background of the study, and the literature review. The abstract elaborates the scientific gap, research problems, and future research in 600-800 words, written in Indonesian and English. Keywords must be relevant to the background of the study and the literature review (a maximum of 5 words). The abstract is written in Indonesian and English.	
<b>3. Literature review (maximum score 40)</b> It contains all aspects of the theory that underlies the research and has disclosure of state-of-the-art theories explaining basic cellular and molecular level mechanisms. It must be relevant to the title and the problem, explain all the variables to be studied and the relationship between variables, and states what is known and not known about the research topic. Sub-chapters shall be arranged correctly with common threads between sub-chapters. Tables, graphs, and pictures are well presented. Paragraphs shall be arranged correctly with common threads between them. Language: use good and correct Indonesian (not a translation). No plagiarism.	
<b>4. Hypothesis (maximum score 15)</b> A hypothesis is an assumption, an idea proposed for the sake of argument to be tested to see if it might be true. It is a statement of expectation or prediction that will be tested by research based on previous theoretical studies, research or literature.	
<b>5. Theoretical Framework (maximum score 10)</b> The student can make a conceptual research framework in the form of a chart containing all research variables; the variables measured reflect the mechanism that can answer the research question. Explanation of the detailed concept framework must contain new findings, scientific gaps, problems, and future research from the literature review.	
<b>6. Reference (maximum score 5)</b> The student must present correct reference writing. The reference must be relevant. The reference must use recent journals as its source with 90% foreign journals (1/3 is a review, 2/3 must be original journals). It must use less than 10% textbooks and less than 10% Indonesian journals.	
<b>7. Presentation (maximum score 10)</b> Written communication is easy to understand, with no redundancy, uses correct, concise and clear Indonesian, and includes references. The oral presentation is on time (not exceeding the time provided of 15-20 minutes). The student can explain figures, tables, and graphs well. The student comprehends the presentation materials well that he/she can explain everything clearly, not merely reading the presentation.	
<b>8. How the student answers questions (maximum score 10)</b> The student answers the questions clearly, briefly, and firmly and demonstrates mastery of the presented materials. The student understands the questions, responds correctly, and explains with tables and charts.
