CRITERIA	SCORE (in figure)
1. Title (maximum score 5) It represents the research objective or results, written in a maximum of 20 words, in Indonesian and English, and provides information about the researcher's work unit.	
2. Summary (maximum score 5) It presents in brief: background of the study, the research problems, the research objectives and methods, research results with average and significant differences, conclusions and suggestions, and keywords (3-5 words). It is written in Indonesian and English and consists of 200-250 words.	
3. Introduction (maximum score 10) It contains 4 paragraphs with the following explanations (1) the research subjects, (2) research procedures that have been done, (3) gaps, and (4) solutions and hypotheses (if any).	
4. Research method (maximum score 10) It briefly tells the method used, the statistical analysis performed, and the ethical clearance.	
5. Findings (maximum score 20) It presents the research findings with the right pictures or graphs completed with a narrative of the pictures or graphs. It presents the means and the standard deviations of the variables studied and significance differences, the statistical analysis suitable with the research needs (ANOVA, correlation, path analysis, etc.). The findings must be relevant to the research problems.	
6. Discussion (maximum score 20) It discusses findings in the researcher's own words, compares findings with previous studies' findings (journals etc.), and explains and provides arguments on the difference or similarity between the present study's findings and previous studies' findings. It also explains limitations as a basis or suggestions for further studies. It must provide relevant references.	
7. Conclusion and recommendations (maximum score 10) The researcher or the student must make conclusions on what has been found and provide suggestions in their own words.	
8. Reference (maximum score 10) The reference follows the Harvard system; the reference from the textbooks cannot be more than 10%, the publication cited shall not be up-to-date (not more than 5 years). If the reference is domestic magazines, then it must be A/B accredited.	
9. Presentation (maximum score 5) The presentation is on time. The student has a clear voice. The student can explain figures, tables, and graphs well. Slides follow the existing rules with only 2-3 colors. The student can answer the question clearly and comprehensively. The student shows good presentation etiquette.	
10. Argumentation (maximum score 5) The presenter must be humble and willing to listen to the suggestion from the audience. The presenter answers the questions clearly, briefly, and firmly and stimulates two-way communication.
